

The Monsanto Farm

Prologue:

(Scene opens inside of an office, Ray is talking to Monsanto corporate after deciding he wants to quit Monsanto's GM crops because he is worried about the consumers.)

Ray: (Worried) Look I am just worried about the consumers of my crop. That is why I am deciding to quit using your crops. I mean BT crops are great, but it produces its own pesticides. Are they toxic?

Ray: (Getting aggravated) Don't you test the food products your self?

Monsanto Worker: You may ask the FDA if you would like to.

Ray: (Stubborn) If you won't let me know I will have to leave your corporation.

Monsanto Worker: That is your choice.

Ray: (Proud) Ok then I will quit.

(Ray Leaves the office by stomping his way through)

Chorus: (other farmers and workers)

You cheat us all Monsanto.

Only for the growth of
Something that should never exist

Scene 1:

(Scene opens on the farm, the month is July the next year. Ray is working on his garden as he notices that there are tons of little insects known as the European Corn Borer.)

Ray: (Shocked, upset) What is thi-... it's the european corn borer and it's too late to spray the field! I bet you they're everywhere.

Chorus:

Monsanto, clever Monsanto.

You knew they were coming.

You knew we wouldn't keep.

These disgusting crops, you knew what they do, you know they can harm if ingested to fill your body with the toxins they make.

A pesticide factory.

Now you make sure we come, crawling back to get the crops.

Ray: (Confident) Not yet we aren't.

(Ray enters his car and drives to Monsanto Corp. He enters and goes to the office from whence he quit)

Ray: (Pleading) Look I need some of the BT crops.

Corporate: (Emotionless) Sorry we don't have any in stock.

Ray: (Angered) BS you have too much of that stuff.

Corporate: Even if we did we would not supply you with the seeds.

Ray: (Burrowing his brows)Why?

Corporate: You quit using BT crops last year remember and you can't use them again until 2 years is up.

Chorus:

He gave up BT because of safety, but his crops are now in danger and you've supplied him with nothing.

Monsanto, you are killing this man for you care for only your precious money and make the population eat something dangerous.

GMO's, the thing Ray was quitting and now regrets it dearly, but you are forced to use BT crops.

That is the sad truth, but is filled with truth and no lies.

His downfall is now happening good bye, Ray, you were the best out there

Scene 2:

(Scene opens with Ray coming home after begging with Monsanto for hours, he's in his

living room, talking to his wife, Rachel)

Ray: (Walks in after begging Monsanto for his job back. He is unsuccessful. He's distraught and worried) Rachel? I have some bad news.

Rachel: (Worried) What is it, Ray?

Ray: (Sighs) Our crops are destroyed, I can't sell them to anyone. After trying to get my job back, Monsanto wouldn't give it back.

Rachel: That's too bad, I figured you'd get a lot of money for those crops.

Ray: Thanks, Rachel, but I have to find another job to keep it in the condition we have now.

Rachel: I don't think that's necessary.

Ray: Why not?

(a rumble is heard outside, sounds like a fancy, sports car)

Ray: (confused) What's that, Rachel?

Rachel: (ignores Ray) I'm going to stay with someone else for right now, maybe bring the kids along... By the way, Robby has been having some stomach issues. I didn't know if it was serious or not.

(She leaves the house and the car speeds away. There is a flushing heard from upstairs where a few groans are heard)

Chorus:

What's this?
Your son, he is sick.
What happened?
Did he get the flu?
What are you going to do?
He's asking to rest, but you won't let him.
As you rush, you are losing your precious son.

Scene 3

(Ray is in a hospital room, holding his daughter as they watch Robby who is unconscious)

(The Doctor walks in)

Ray: Well is he alive? May I see him?

Doctor: Come with me.

(Ray and the Doctor walk to Robby's room who is hooked up to multiple machines)

Ray: (Saddened at his terrible state) Is there anything left that I can do?

Doctor: There is not much we can do.

Ray: What?! Why?!

Doctor: He's going to die very soon. We were too late. He's in some kind of shock and will soon run out of fluids and die. . . I will leave you alone.

(A few hours later with Ray sitting beside Robby as the doctor comes in)

Doctor: Mr. Newford, we have some more information of why your son is sick.

Ray: (looks at doctor) R-Really? What is it?

Doctor: It was an allergic reaction to some corn shells. He's actually living past the time he was suppose to.

Ray: Wait, we ate tacos a couple of days ago. They were GM corn tacos.

Doctor: Yes, they are know to be a common allergen.

Scene 4 (final scene)

(Scene opens a few weeks later in a graveyard. There is Rachel, Ray, their daughter, and Richard surrounding a gravestone. Ray and Rachel are now divorced as well)

Ray: He was too young...

(Ray crouches down and puts some flowers on his son's grave. His daughter, Ruby, is crying a little as well.)

Ruby: Why can't he come back? (Looking at her parents)

Ray: (sighs) He's in a better place and doesn't want to leave.

Chorus: (Other mourners)

Monsanto Monsanto.

Look what you have done.

A child, innocent and pure, has died from something that nature never developed normally

Why, Monsanto?

Don't you have any soul?

To know what you've done?

If the corn can kill insects, can't it kill us?

Don't you know how much,

This family had gone through just with you?

They haven't touched your 'Frankenstein Food', but they suffered from it.
